


Exceptional Cultural Heritage







Life's a Beach


Blissful Arugam Bay

The ideal time to visit Arugam Bay is May to September as the monsoon kicks from October onwards, if you're not into surfing, take a boat ride to the lagoon, long walk along the coastal beach or can do yoga lessons on the beach or simply lie back on the soft sand and enjoy the sun and waves of the Indian Ocean.

Concealed Mirissa

This tiny pristine beach is located four kilometers south-east of Weligama (Weligama is a popular fishing coastal fishing village), not far from the southern tip of the Island. Mirissa is well known for amazing sunsets and swaying coconut trees. Riding the waves and indulging yourself in that feeling of welcome seclusion is par for the course in this part of the world. Mirissa is a world's one of top hotspots to spot giant sea creatures "Blue Whales & Sperm whales" and dolphins.





Sun- Kissed Bentota



The resort town of Bentota is located 60 kilometers from Colombo. An oasis for the self- proclaimed resort lover, here is a coastal haven dotted with boutique hotels, luxury hotel chains and few international hotels.

In addition to the long stretches of busy beaches, adventure tours, bar life, nightlife and fresh seafood are also on offer. Bentota is a water sports paradise, canoeing, sailing, windsurfing, Jet skiing, and banana boat rides are best enjoyed in Bentota. The best time to visit Bentota is November to April. Bentota is a popular beach destination among European travelers who seek a perfect relaxing beach stays.

Vibe of Unawatuna

Touted as being the best beach on the country by many, Unawatuna beach is popular for its silken shores and laid back vibes. In 2014, Unawatuna was listed among CNN Travel's world's 100 best beaches with special mention being made of the swaying palm trees and thatched huts that grace is shores. This little heaven is located a mere six kilometers southeast of "Galle Dutch Fort", this escape is rich in biodiversity. The water and waterfront are known to be home to many species of rare birds, ducks, coral reefs, shipwrecks a variety of fish and even turtles that wade on to the shore.





Sandy Hikkaduwa

Hikkaduwa is a small beach town which is located on the southwestern of Sri Lanka. This town is 98km from the commercial capital – Colombo and it's an approximately one hour drive via the highway from Colombo. This little fun coastal town has one of most beautiful & pristine beaches to be discovered by tourists. Snorkeling and diving in the clear waters are a major past-time along this stretch and is the most environmentally friendly way to see the colorful fish that dart around. The coral reef of Hikkaduwa is another highlight and glass boats tours are arranged for local travelers & tourists. There are plenty of hotels along the coast and travelers can find any standard of hotels in Hikkaduwa. Also this area is full of sea food restaurants, local pubs, bars, shops and super markets. This is a relaxing hot spot at the beach and we recommend our travelers to stay minimum two nights in Hikkaduwa.

Fun-Filled Negombo

Negombo is located 40 kilometers from the commercial capital of Sri Lanka - Colombo and it's an one hour drive. Negombo is an ideal travel destination for those on a short stopover since its located not far from the Bandaranaike International Airport. The drive is approximately 30 minutes. Negombo boasts some of the finest beaches in the country and is blessed with bright sunshine and clear blue skies. Negombo is fringed by the pristine waters of the Indian Ocean and is ideal to relax or indulge in a tropical environment. You can do beach volleyballs and water polo thrive on Negombo beach and in dozens of swimming pools around the city. There are dozens of luxury hotels, middle class hotels, guest houses, motels and backpacker accommodations around the city and along the beach streets of Negombo.






Untouched Nilaveli

Nilaveli beahc is an unspoilt pristine, stretch of beach located 15 kilometers north of Trincomalee town in the eastern province. This beach is well known for being one of the cleanest beaches in the island with its pure white sand and a serene beachfront that stretches for miles. Lying on it, watching the sun glint off the aquamarine and turquoise waters, is a beach lover's must do. Nilaveli is popular and ideal for leisure activities such as sunbathing, swimming, surfing, diving and scuba diving. The best time to visit beach is March to October because the weather is ideal for recreational activities. The Pigeon Island is the top highlight of Nilaveli Beach where shallows reefs, corals and dozens of species of vibrant reef fish and eels that are ready made for snorkeling abound. The Island is one of two marine national parks in Sri Lanka

Tranquil Pasikuda

One of the best wide and pristine beaches on the island and it's easy to see why. Pasikuda is a small coastal village located 35 kilometers from Batticaloa town on the eastern belt. This sandy beach haven is well known for its clear and shallow but mostly calm waters. This is also a paradise for family vacations, honeymooners as well as snorkeling and scuba diving.






Wildlife Escapades

Tear drop shaped island- Sri Lanka has become one of the most desired destination in the world for safari adventures. According to the Forbes magazine, Sri Lanka has been identified as the Best Safari Destination outside of Africa. Sri Lanka boasts one of the highest biological endemism rates for fauna & flora and is among the top five biodiversity hotspots in the world. The wildlife of the Sri Lanka is as varied as the island itself, extending from Asian elephants and leopards to marine life and a vast number of different birds, Also Sri Lanka is now one of the best places in the world to see whales, including the mighty blue whale, sperm whale and Dolphins.

The Land of Big Cats Yala National Park

Yala West (Ruhunu) National park is well known & recognized as one of the best parks in the world to spot and photograph "Leopards". Situated 309km south of Colombo. This park is the Sri Lanka's oldest and the second largest national park which covers about over 100,000 hectares (1,259 Square Kilometers). Yala national park is divided into five blocks. Block one is the most visited area since it contains the highest density of leopards. Other areas of Yala such as Yala East had been closed to visitors for some years it will take time to research leopard numbers in these areas. Yala west consists of scrub forest, brackish lagoons and stunning rock monoliths scattered throughout the park, its eastern edge is bounded by the south East Coast. In jeep safari tours of Yala National park, it is possible to take a full day jeep safaris (Starts at 06.00am and finishes at 18.00pm) or split your day into morning & evening safari sessions. The best chance to spot leopards is generally early in the morning and then again at dusk.






Lush Udawalawe National Park

Situated 170km, south east of Colombo (250km from the Center of Colombo). Udawalawe National park is approximately 30,821 hectares in extent. This park lies within the Ratnapura and Monaragala Districts acts as the catchment to the Udawalawe reservoir and is located in the dry zone. This park comprises grasslands and thorn scrubs and many valuable species of trees are found inside the park. Udawalawe national park is one of best national parks in Sri Lanka to spot Asian wild elephants, especially large herds of elephants can be seen during safari tours. This is a homeland to approximately 400 wild elephants. Spotted deer, sambar, barking deer, wild boar, water buffalo and jackal are some of prominent wild animals found in this park. A 4X4 open top safari is the only way to see all the wonders that this protected reserve has to offer and our experienced and knowledgeable naturalists will make this an unforgettable safari experience.

Daring Wilpattu National Park

Wilpattu National park is situated in 170km north of Colombo and this park is considered as the largest national park of Sri Lanka which covers approximately 1,31,690 hectares and reaches 152meters from the sea level. Wilpattu national park means "Park of Lakes". The park has a dense forest cover which makes it a more exciting park where animals have to be tracked. There are numerous delightful little lakes known as "Villus" (natural lakes). This park is a paradise for leopards, sloth bears, elephants, spotted deer, crocodiles and different species of Birds such as painted strokes, open bill, little cormorant, Sri Lankan jungle fowl, falcons, gulls and different varieties. We arrange half a day (3 hours safari trip) & full day safari sessions (06.00am until 18.00pm) at Wilpattu National park for visitors who would like to experience a true safari encounter.






The Kingdom of Jumbos Minneriya National Park

Minneriya National park is one of Major Park for safari lovers and the park is located 182 kilometers away from Colombo in the province of North Central. The nearest and the major city to Minneriya National park is Polonnaruwa. Minneriya National park is well known and considered as the largest known wild Asian elephant gathering at once place in the world. This national park is spread over 8,889 hectares and an ideal grasslands for elephants. The best time to visit Minneriya is from month of May to month of October. The renovated vast reservoir is the heart of Minneriya National park as it is the main water resource for all animals and the main key of wild elephant gathering. Apart from wild elephants, Minneriya national park is a home to spotted deer, grey langur monkeys, purple face leaf monkey, Wild boar, crocodiles, leopards (very rare), sloth bear (Very rare), and also a land for endemic birds such as Grey Horn bill, Green pigeon and brown capped Babbler.

Paradise of Birds Bundala National Park

Bundala National park is located 250 kilometers from the capital- Colombo. This park is belong to the Dry zone, the generally the climate is hot and dry. Bundala National park is one of the best destinations for birds in Sri Lanka. Every bird watcher or lover definitely visits this park and the bet time to visit this park is from month of September to month of March. Bundala is a home to 32 species of mammals, nearly 200 species of birds and different species of reptiles. Wild elephants, wild boar, leopard, sloth bear, jackals and Toque Macaque are the common mammals can be seen in Bundala National park.

Different kind of Pelicans, strokes like painted strokes, Black necked strokes, Terns, sand pipers, egrets, spoonbills and endemic birds like Brown capped babbler, Ceylon woodshrike and Ceylon Jungle fowl can been spotted during the tour,





Misty Horton Plains National Park

Horton Plains National Park is located in the central highlands of Sri Lanka which at an altitude of 2,100 meters above sea level. The location is the coldest and windiest location in the country.

It consists of ecosystems such as Montane evergreen forests, grasslands, marshy lands and aquatic ecosystem. This misty and cold national park spreads across over 3,169 hectares of the highest plains of the island and it is rich of large number of endemic flora and fauna species. Horton Plains was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site on 30th of July 2010. The closest town of Horton Plains is Nuwara Eliya which is well known as Little England. Travelers can stay an overnight in Nuwara Eliya and can reach to Horoton Plains within a drive of one hour. The 6.2 miles circuit trekking is very popular among the local and foriegn travelers, And travelers can reach to Bakers Waterfall, The World's End cliff and the Mini world's End cliff during the trekking.



The Finest Taste Ceylon Tea

Sri Lanka has the World's best tea and well known as "Ceylon Tea". Sri Lanka is one of the most famous countries to produce tea and is one of the most fabulously enjoyed beverages in Sri Lanka. The ideal climatic conditions play a major role in the success of the growth of tea in Sri Lanka. 4% of the country's land is covered by tea plantations. The main tea growing areas are Nuwara Eliya, Kandy, Central Province, Bandarawela, Haputale, Uva Province, Galle, Matara, Southern Province, Ratnapura, Kegalle, Sabaragamuwa Provinces. Ceylon Black Tea is the most famously known tea around the globe. The high-grown black tea has a honey golden liquor and light and is among the best teas which have a distinct flavor, aroma, and strength. Ceylon black tea is famous around the world and is used as the base for many blends such as Earl Grey tea, and much other fruit flavored teas. Black tea is not the only tea produced, Sri Lanka produces Green tea, silver tea and White tea.




Sri Lankan Arts & Crafts
